

Maintenance Instructions: **DuraGloss**

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DURAGLOSS:

Remove loose dirt and soil by sweeping or vacuuming. For best results, the area to be buffed should be precleaned with ProtectOHM to remove fine dirt and soils that can become embedded during high speed burnishing procedures.

Dilute DuraGloss at 8 ounces per gallon of cold water. Using a bucketless mop or comparable system equipped with a microfiber cleaning or finish application flat mop, damp mop the area to be burnished.

Allow the mopped area to dry, then, using a 1500-2500 Rpm burnisher equipped with a white or similar soft pad, with limited pressure or burnishing equipment set to “float,” burnish areas, making several passes to maintain or restore gloss.

NOTE: burnishing area while they are still damp or in high humidity conditions may result in hazing of the finish surface. Wash and rinse buffing pads after each application.

For optimum results, do not apply under high humidity conditions.
